6	SECTION 1. G.S. 120-3.1(c) reads as rewritten:		
7	"(c) When the General Assembly by joint action of the two houses adjourns to a		
8	day certain, which day is more than three days after the date of adjournment, the period		
9	between the date of adjournment and the date of reconvening shall for the purposes of		
10	this section be deemed to be a period when the General Assembly is not in session, and		
11	no member shall be entitled to subsistence and travel allowance during that period,		
12	except under circumstances which would entitle him to subsistence and travel allowance		
13	when the General Assembly is not in session. If the Current Operations Appropriations		
14	Act has not been ratified by June 30 of any calendar year, no member shall be entitled to		
15	subsistence allowance for the period beginning July 1 of that year and ending when the

- Current Operations Appropriations Act has been ratified." SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. 17
