on North Carolina history and geography to all students in the fourth g	grade and all
students in the eighth grade. The course at each grade level may include	le up to four
weeks of instruction relating to the local area in which the students reside."	-
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and	applies to all
school years beginning with the 2001-2002 school year.
