10 11 The Department of Justice shall enter into a written reciprocity agreement with the appropriate agency in each state: (i) that agrees to permit North Carolina residents to carry concealed handguns in the other state on the basis of a North Carolina-issued concealed handgun permit, or (ii) that will issue a license to carry a concealed handgun in the other state based upon a North Carolina concealed handgun permit. If a reciprocity agreement is reached, the requirement to contact the other state each six months shall be eliminated as long as the reciprocity agreement is in force. Each reciprocity agreement shall be a public record and shall be available to individual requesters free of charge for the first copy and at the normal rate for open records requests for additional copies."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
