A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NORTH CAROLINA MEDICAL BOARD TO 3 REQUIRE ANY PERSON TREATING A PATIENT BY USE OF THE INTERNET OR A TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE NUMBER TO OBTAIN A 4 LICENSE IN THIS STATE. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 90-18 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 8 "(a1) No person shall treat or prescribe medication to a patient by use of the Internet or a toll-free telephone number unless the person is licensed and registered in 9 this State as provided in this Article. This subsection shall not apply to an out-of-state 10 physician who is contacted by one of his or her regular patients for treatment by use of 11 the Internet or a toll-free phone line while the patient is temporarily in this State." 12 13 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
