2	AN ACT TO STAGGER THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE MARINE				
3	FISHERIES COMMISSION, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT				
4	LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON SEAFOOD AND AQUACULTURE.				
5	5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 143B-289.54(d) reads as rewritten:				
7	"(d) Terms. – The term of office of members of the Commission is three years. A				
8	member may be reappointed to any number of successive three-year terms. Upon the				
9	expiration of a three-year term, a member shall continue to serve until a successor is				
10	appointed and duly qualified as provided by G.S. 128-7. The term of members				
11	appointed under subdivisions (1), (2), and (3) (4), and (7) of subsection (a) of this				
12	section shall expire on 30 June of years evenly divisible by three. The term of members				
13	appointed under subdivisions (4), (5), and (6) (2), (5), and (8) of subsection (a) of this				
14	section shall expire on 30 June of years that precede by one year those years that are				
15	5 evenly divisible by three. The term of members appointed under subdivisions $(7)$ , $(8)$ ,				
16	5 (3), (6), and (9) of subsection (a) of this section shall expire on 30 June of years that				
17	7 follow by one year those years that are evenly divisible by three."				
18	<b>SECTION 2.</b> In order to alter the schedule of staggered terms of three years				
19	for the Marine Fisheries Commission and to provide for an orderly transition in				
20	membership of the Commission as specified in G.S. 143B-289.54, as amended by				
21	Section 1 of this act, notwithstanding G.S. 143B-289.54(d), the following provisions				
22	apply:				
23	(1) Willy Phillips shall serve in the position established by G.S.				
24	143B-289.54(a)(1) through June 30, 2001.				
25	(2) Robert Southerland shall serve in the position established by G.S.				
26	143B-289.54(a)(2) through June 30, 2001. The term of the individual				
27	next appointed to fill this position shall be for two years and shall				
28	expire June 30, 2003.
