A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF 3 ESTABLISHING A STATE MILITARY MUSEUM. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: The Department of Cultural Resources shall study the SECTION 1. 5 feasibility of establishing a State Military Museum. The Department shall report its 6 findings, including any recommendations, to the General Assembly no later than 7 February 1, 2002. 8 9 There is appropriated from the General Fund to the SECTION 2. Department of Cultural Resources the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 10 2001-2002 fiscal year to study the feasibility of establishing a State Military Museum. 11 SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001. 12
