9	deductions under section 162(1) of the Code for health insurance cost
10	of self-employed individuals would have increased if the applicable
11	percentage in section 162(1)(1)(B) of the Code for the taxable year
12	were one hundred percent (100%)."
13	SECTION 2. This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after
14	January 1, 2001.
