A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SINGLE-MEMBER
DISTRICTS FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 1 of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes is amended
by adding a new section to read:

"§ 120-2.3. Single-member districts required in House and Senate.

An act of the General Assembly that revises Senate or House districts after the return
of a decennial federal census shall consist exclusively of single-member districts."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
