A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR REPAIRS TO THE HISTORIC GILL
HOUSE IN SCOTLAND COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year for the Scotland County Historical Properties Commission for repairs to the historic Gill House. The house was the residence of former State Treasurer Edwin Gill and is currently owned by the Scotland County Historical Properties Commission.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
