SECTION 1. Article 14 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 116-143.6. Full scholarship students attending constituent institutions.

- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any nonresident person who receives a full scholarship to a constituent institution and who attends the institution shall be considered and treated for all purposes of The University of North Carolina as a resident of North Carolina.
 - The following definitions apply in this section: (b)
 - 'Full scholarship' means a grant that meets the full cost for a student to (1) attend the constituent institution for an academic year.
 - 'Full cost' means an amount calculated by the constituent institution (2) that is no less than the sum of in-State tuition, required fees, oncampus room and board, and required course-related books."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to students who receive full scholarships on or after that date.
