**BILL SUMMARY**: This bill waives the penalties for failure to file returns, reports and payments in a timely manner due a presidentially declared disaster.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** There is no fiscal impact for this bill because the bill conforms state law to the actual administrative practice of the Department of Revenue. In the aftermath of Hurricanes Fran and Floyd, the Department waived additional penalties on the failure to file returns and the failure to make timely tax payments in storm ravaged areas of the state.
