The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. It is unlawful to take or kill any wild animal or	wild bird with
the use of a firearm or to discharge a firearm from, on, or across the rig	ht-of-way of a
public road, street, highway, or other public vehicular area in Clay	and Cherokee
Counties.	
SECTION 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.	
SECTION 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement of	officers of the
Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by	peace officers
with general subject matter jurisdiction.	
SECTION 4. This act applies only to Cherokee and Clay Cour	nties.
SECTION 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 2004,	and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.
