2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FORCE ACCOUNT LIMIT FOR THE CITY OF
3	NEWTON AND CATAWBA COUNTY AS TO A PARK.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 143-135 reads as rewritten:
6	" § 143-135. Limitation of application of Article.
7	Except for the provisions of G.S. 143-129 requiring bids for the purchase of
8	apparatus, supplies, materials or equipment, this Article shall not apply to construction
9	or repair work undertaken by the State or by subdivisions of the State of North Carolina
10	(i) when the work is performed by duly elected officers or agents using force account
11	qualified labor on the permanent payroll of the agency concerned and (ii) when either
12	the total cost of the project, including without limitation all direct and indirect costs of
13	labor, services, materials, supplies and equipment, does not exceed one hundred
14	twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) or the total cost of labor on the project does not
15	exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). eight hundred sixty thousand dollars
16	(\$860,000). This force account work shall be subject to the approval of the Director of
17	the Budget in the case of State agencies, of the responsible commission, council, or
18	board in the case of subdivisions of the State. Complete and accurate records of the
19	entire cost of such work, including without limitation, all direct and indirect costs of
20	labor, services, materials, supplies and equipment performed and furnished in the
21	prosecution and completion thereof, shall be maintained by such agency, commission,
22	council or board for the inspection by the general public. Construction or repair work
23	undertaken pursuant to this section shall not be divided for the purposes of evading the
24	provisions of this Article."
25	SECTION 2. This act applies only to the construction of a park on City of
26	Newton property on North Carolina Highway 10 West.

27 **SECTION 3.** This act applies only to the City of Newton and Catawba 28 County.
