1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE CURRITUCK ALCOHOLIC
3	BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD FROM THREE TO FIVE MEMBERS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S.18B-700(a) reads as rewritten:
6	"(a) Membership. – A local ABC board shall consist of three-five members
7	appointed for three-year terms, unless a different membership or term is provided by a
8	local act enacted before the effective date of this Chapter, or unless the board is a board
9	for a merged ABC system under G.S. 18B-703 and a different size membership has
10	been provided for as part of the negotiated merger. One member of the initial board of a
11	newly created ABC system shall be appointed for a three-year term, one member for a
12	two year term, and one member for a one year term. terms. As the terms of initial board
13	members expire, their successors shall each be appointed for three-year terms. The
14	appointing authority shall designate one member of the local board as chairman. The
15	three members appointed prior to the effective date of this act shall complete their terms
16	as appointed. The two new members appointed after the effective date of this act shall
17	be appointed as provided in Section 2 of this act."
18	SECTION 2. The Board of Commissioners shall appoint additional
19	members authorized by this act to serve one-year and two-year initial terms and then for
20	three-year terms thereafter. The initial terms shall be decided upon to maintain the
21	staggered appoint periods required by G.S. 18B-700(a) as amended by Section 1 of this
22	act.
23	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act applies to Currituck County only.
24	<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
