1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ADVISORY COMMISSION
3 ON MILITARY AFFAIRS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 127C-2 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 127C-2. Membership.

7 (a) The North Carolina Advisory Commission on Military Affairs shall consist of
8 21 voting members, who shall serve on the Executive Committee, and ~~nine~~ 15
9 nonvoting, ex officio members who shall serve by reason of their positions.

10 (b) The Executive Committee shall be appointed as follows:

11 (1) Three members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
12 Representatives, one of whom shall be a member of a recognized
13 veterans' organization.

14 (2) Three members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate,
15 one of whom shall be a member of a recognized veterans' organization.

16 (3) Fifteen members appointed by the Governor, consisting of:

17 a. Three representatives from the Jacksonville community.

18 b. Three representatives from the Havelock community.

19 c. Three representatives from the Goldsboro community.

20 d. Three representatives from the Fayetteville community.

21 e. Three public members from across the State.

22 (c) The following ~~members~~ members, or their designee, shall serve ex officio:

23 (1) The Lieutenant Governor.

24 ~~(1)(2)~~ Secretary of Crime Control and Public Safety, or a designee. Safety.

25 ~~(2)(3)~~ Secretary of Commerce, or a designee. Commerce.

26 (4) The Secretary of Transportation.

27 (5) The Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural

8 (13) The Executive Director of the North Carolina League of
9 Municipalities.
10 (14) The Executive Director of the North Carolina Association of County
11 Commissioners.
12 (15) The Assistant Secretary for Veterans Affairs, Department of
13 Administration.
14 (d) The Governor shall designate one member of the Executive Committee
15 appointed pursuant to subsection (b) of this section to serve as chair. The Executive
16 Committee shall elect four persons from amongst its membership to serve as
17 vice-chairs.
18 (e) The terms of the members of the Executive Committee shall be as follows:
19 (1) The members initially appointed by the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall
21 serve terms ending on December 31, 2003.
22 (2) Seven of the members appointed by the Governor shall serve initial
23 terms ending on December 31, 2002.
24 (3) Eight of the members appointed by the Governor shall serve initial
25 terms ending on December 31, 2003.
26 Thereafter, all members shall serve two-year terms."
27 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
