A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
2 STUDY THE LIMITATION ON POSTRETIREMENT EARNINGS BY
3 RETIREES AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THAT STUDY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission may study the impact
6 of the limitation on postretirement earnings by retirees, as well as limitations on the
7 purchase of service credits for creditable federal and out-of-state service, in particular
8 the impact of these limitations on the ability of local governments to recruit and retain
9 competent employees.

10 **SECTION 2.** The Legislative Research Commission shall report the results
11 of its study, including any recommended legislation, to the 2005 General Assembly.

12 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated by the General Fund to the General
13 Assembly the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to
14 implement the provisions of this act.

15 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
