Short Title: Electrofishing/Waccamaw and Lumber Rivers. (Local) **Sponsors:** Senator Soles. Referred to: State Government, Local Government, and Veterans' Affairs. March 20, 2003 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOW ELECTROFISHING FOR CATFISH IN COLUMBUS COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person who holds a current and valid special device license, as defined in G.S. 113-272.2, may use a hand-operated device which generates an electric current for taking catfish. **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to those portions of the Waccamaw River located in Columbus County and to those portions of the Lumber River located in Columbus County. **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
