The Speaker may appoint select committees under RULE 26. 4 5 Notwithstanding RULE 31(a), any bill or resolution shall be (4) 6 introduced by submitting the bill or resolution to the Principal Clerk's 7 Office. 8 (5) Notwithstanding RULES 31 and 31.1: 9 The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in 10 the House are resolutions adjourning the 2004 Extra Session sine die. 11 12 All bills shall be excluded from introduction or consideration in b. 13 the House, other than bills concerning matters described in the 14 Governor's Proclamation of an Extra Session dated October 27, 15 2004. 16 (6) RULE 31.1 shall not apply to resolutions adjourning the 2004 Extra 17 Session sine die and bills concerning matters described in the 18 Governor's Proclamation of an Extra Session dated October 27, 2004. 19 (7) Notwithstanding RULES 32, 38, and 41, a resolution or bill may be placed on the calendar without being referred by the Speaker to a 20 21 committee and on the same legislative day of its introduction or receipt 22 from the Senate. 23 (8) Notwithstanding RULE 36(a), all House bills and resolutions may be reported from the standing committee or permanent subcommittee to 24 which referred with recommendations as the standing committee or 25 permanent subcommittee may desire to make. 26 27 (9) Notwithstanding RULE 41: The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a 28 a. 29 House bill shall occur on the legislative day of its introduction. 30 The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a Senate bill shall occur on the legislative day of its receipt on 31 32 messages from the Senate. The Speaker shall give notice at each 33 subsequent reading whether it is the second or third reading. 34 Except for a bill governed by Article II, Section 23 of the North b. 35 Carolina Constitution, a bill may be read more than once on the same day. 36 Notwithstanding RULE 44(d), a conference report may be placed on 37 (10)the calendar for the legislative day on which the report is received. 38 39 Notwithstanding RULE 59, any member wishing to cosponsor a bill or (11)resolution that has been introduced may do so by appearing in the 40 office of the Principal Clerk for that purpose on the day during which 41 42 the bill or resolution was first read and referred, but only while the bill
