Short Title: Hunting and Fishing on Tribal Land. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ALLOW MEMBERS OF STATE-RECOGNIZED INDIAN TRIBES TO
2 HUNT, TRAP, OR FISH ON TRIBAL LANDS WITHOUT OBTAINING A
3 LICENSE ISSUED BY THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 113-276 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 "(11) The licensing provisions of this Article do not apply to a member of an Indian
8 tribe recognized under Chapter 71A of the General Statutes for purposes of hunting,
9 trapping, or fishing on tribal land. A person taking advantage of this exemption shall
10 possess and produce proper identification confirming the person's membership in a
11 State-recognized tribe upon request by a wildlife enforcement officer. For purposes of
12 this section, "tribal land" means only real property owned by an Indian tribe recognized
13 under Chapter 71A of the General Statutes."

14 **SECTION 2.** The Commission of Indian Affairs shall provide the Wildlife
15 Resources Commission with a list of properties owned by State-recognized tribes in this
16 State and update that list whenever additional land is acquired by a tribe. Each tribe
17 shall post tribal land to give notice of its ownership by the tribe.

18 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
