A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IN FILLING A VACANCY IN THE BOARD OF  
2 EDUCATION OF JONES COUNTY, THE JONES COUNTY BOARD OF  
3 EDUCATION MUST APPOINT THE NOMINEE OF THE PARTY EXECUTIVE  
4 COMMITTEE OF THE VACATING OFFICER.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 349 of the 1973 Session Laws is amended by adding a  
8 new section to read:

9 "Section 3.1. Vacancies on the Jones County Board of Education shall be filled by  
10 appointment of the remaining members, in accordance with G.S. 115C-37.1."

11 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 115C-37.1(d) reads as rewritten:

12 "(d) This section shall apply only in the following counties: Alamance, Alleghany,  
13 Avery, Beaufort, Brunswick, Buncombe, Burke, Cabarrus, Caldwell, Carteret,  
14 Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Graham, Guilford, Haywood,  
15 Henderson, Jackson, Jones, Madison, McDowell, Mecklenburg, Moore, New Hanover,  
16 Polk, Randolph, Rockingham, Rutherford, Stanly, Stokes, Transylvania, Vance, Wake,  
17 Washington, and Yancey."

18 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
