4	SECTION 2. The New Hanover County Board of Education shall not			
5	implement any success centers in the New Hanover County Schools until it has			
6	completed the study required by Section 1 of this act and filed the study with the Joint			
7	Legislative Education Oversight Committee.			
8	<b>SECTION 3.</b> The New Hanover County Board of Education shall report its			
9	objectives, findings. and any recommendations for implementing success centers to the			
10	Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee no later than August 1, 2005.			
11	<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act applies only to the New Hanover County School			
12	Administrative Unit.			
13	<b>SECTION 5.</b> Nothing in this act requires the North Carolina General			
14	Assembly to appropriate funds for the study or for the implementation of Success			
15	Centers.			
16	<b>SECTION 6.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
