9	<u>(1</u>	The wishes of the child's parent as to the child's custody.
10	<u>(2</u>	The wishes of the child as to the child's custodian.
11	<u>(3</u>	The interaction and interrelationship of the child with his or her parent,
12		siblings, or any other person who may significantly affect the child's
13		best interest.
14	<u>(4</u>	The child's adjustment to his or her home, school, and community.
15	<u>(5</u>	The mental and physical health of all individuals involved.
16	The court shall not consider conduct of a proposed custodian that does not affect the	
17	custodian's relationship to the child."
