11	<u>(3)</u>	The interaction and interrelationship of the child with his or her	r parent,	
12		siblings, or any other person who may significantly affect the	e child's	
13		best interest.		
14	<u>(4)</u>	The child's adjustment to his or her home, school, and commun	<u>ity.</u>	
15	<u>(5)</u>	The mental and physical health of all individuals involved.		
16	The court shall not consider conduct of a proposed custodian that does not affect the			
17	custodian's relationship to the child."
