A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO  
INCREASE THE NUMBER OF DNA CRIME LAB INVESTIGATORS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice the sum of one hundred sixty-six thousand six hundred fifteen dollars (\$166,615) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of four hundred sixty-eight thousand ninety-seven dollars (\$468,097) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to fund seven new DNA investigators to expedite DNA analysis and speed the review, auditing, and uploading of DNA profiles into the DNA database (CODIS).

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
