A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE FORMULA FOR THE PURCHASE OF PART-TIME SERVICE IN THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 135-4(p1)(1) reads as rewritten:

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, upon completion 8 of five years of membership service, any member may purchase service previously rendered as a part-time teacher or employee of an 9 employer as defined in G.S. 135-1(11) or G.S. 128-21(11), except for 10 temporary or part-time service rendered while a full-time student in 11 pursuit of a degree or diploma in a degree-granting program. Service 12 may be purchased either in full or in one-year increments. Payment 13 shall be made in a single lump sum in an amount equal to the full 14 actuarial cost of providing credit for the service, twelve percent (12%) 15 of compensation at the time of service plus interest compounded 16 annually at the rate of six and one-half percent (6.5%) for each 17 calendar year from the year of part-time service to the year of service 18 purchase, together with interest and an administrative fee, as 19 determined by the Board of Trustees on the advice of the Retirement 20 System's actuary. Trustees. Notwithstanding the provisions of 21 G.S. 135-4(b), the Board of Trustees shall fix and determine by 22 appropriate rules and regulations how much service in any year, as 23 based on compensation, is equivalent to one year of service in 24 proportion to "earnable compensation", but in no case shall more than 25 one year of service be creditable for all service in one year. Service 26 rendered for the regular school year in any district shall be equivalent 27

to one year's service. For the purpose of computing a one-year 1 increment for service by employees not in school districts, 2 3 three-fourths time or greater shall be considered full-time. 4 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this subdivision that provide for the purchase of service credits, the terms "full cost", "full 5 liability", and "full actuarial cost" include assumed annual 6 post retirement allowance increases, as determined by the Board of 7 Trustees, from the earliest age at which a member could retire on an 8 9 unreduced service allowance."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
