A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CREATE AN OFFENSE FOR THREATS AGAINST SCHOOL
PROPERTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
new section to read:

"§ 14-16.9A. Threats against school property.

(a) Any person who knowingly and willfully makes any threat to damage or
harm the property of any school facility with the use of a firearm, explosives, or fire
shall be guilty of a Class I felony.

(b) Any person who knowingly and willfully makes any threat to damage or
harm the property of any school facility by means other than firearm, explosives, or fire
shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.
