A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES IN THE EDUCATIONAL DISTRICTS FROM
2 WHICH MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION ARE
3 APPOINTED.

5 Whereas, the Constitution states that the State Board of Education shall
6 consist of the Lieutenant Governor, the Treasurer, and 11 members appointed by the
7 Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly in joint session; and

8 Whereas, the Constitution directs the General Assembly to divide the State
9 into eight educational districts; and

10 Whereas, the Constitution further directs the Governor to appoint one
11 member of the State Board of Education from each of the eight educational districts and
12 three members from the State at large; and

13 Whereas, the General Assembly has not reconfigured the eight educational
14 districts since 1945; Now, therefore,

15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-65 reads as rewritten:
17 "**§ 115C-65. State divided into districts.**"

18 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
