9	General Statutes shall be allocated for capital projects for school construction projects				
10	as follows: (1) A	sum equal to sixty five percent (65%) of those monies			
11	transferred in accordance with G.S. 18C-164 shall be allocated on a per average daily				
12	membership basis according to the average daily membership for the budget year as				
13	determined and certified by the State Board of Education.				
14	(2) A sum	equal to thirty-five percent (35%) of those monies transferred in			
15	accore	lance with G.S. 18C-164 shall be allocated to those local school			
16	admin	istrative units located in whole or part in counties in which the			
17	effective county tax rate as a percentage of the effective State average				
18	tax rate is greater than one hundred percent (100%), with the following				
19	definit	tions applying to this subdivision:			
20	a.	"Effective county tax rate" means the actual county tax rate			
21		multiplied by a three year weighted average of the most recent			
22		annual sales assessment ratio studies.			
23	b.	"State average effective tax rate" means the average effective

25	e.	"Sales assessment ratio studies" means sales assessment ratio
