A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWNS OF BENSON, CASWELL BEACH,
CHADBOURN, AND TABOR CITY TO REGULATE GOLF CARTS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Section 3 of S.L. 2005-11 reads as rewritten:
"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act applies only to the Towns of Benson,
Bladenboro, Chadbourn, Elizabethtown, Rose Hill and Bladenboro. and Tabor City.
Section 2 of this act applies only to Moore County."
SECTION 1.1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and
G.S. 20-54, the Town of Caswell Beach may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of
golf carts on any street or road within the confines of the municipal limits of Caswell
Beach. By ordinance, the Town may require the registration of golf carts, specify the
persons authorized to operate golf carts, and specify required equipment, load limits,
and the hours and methods of operation of the golf carts.
SECTION 1.2. S.L. 2005-58 is repealed.
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
