1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE
3 CONCERNING THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD FOR THE CITY OF
4 CHARLOTTE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.61(a) of the Charter of the City of Charlotte, being
7 S.L. 2000-26, as amended, reads as rewritten:

8 "Section 4.61. **Civil service Board; Membership, Powers and Duties.** (a)
9 Establishment. There is hereby ~~continued established~~ a civil service Board for the City
10 of Charlotte, to consist of ~~five members and two alternates; three members and one~~
11 ~~alternate to seven members, four members to~~ be appointed by the Council and ~~two~~
12 ~~members and one alternate three members~~ to be appointed by the Mayor. Each member
13 shall serve for a term of three years. In case of a vacancy on the Board, the Council or
14 the Mayor, as the case may be, shall fill such vacancy for the unexpired term of said
15 member. For the purposes of establishing a quorum of the Board, ~~any combination of~~
16 ~~Board members and alternates totaling a total of three members shall~~ constitute a
17 quorum. All Board members ~~and alternates shall~~ attend regular meetings for the
18 purposes of meeting attendance policy and familiarity with Board business and
19 procedures. ~~Alternates shall attend hearings when needed due to scheduling conflicts of~~
20 ~~regular Board members and shall vote only when serving in the absence of a regular~~
21 ~~Board member.~~ Attendance at meetings and continued service on the Board shall be
22 governed by the attendance policies established by the Council. Vacancies resulting
23 from a member's failure to attend the required number of meetings or hearings shall be
24 filled as provided herein.

25 Those individuals appointed by either the Council or the Mayor prior to January 1,
26 2007, to serve as alternates to the Civil Service Board shall automatically become
27 members of the Civil Service Board for the remainder of their unexpired terms as
28 alternates."

29 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2007.
