A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT A REPLICA OF A
ROSENWALD SCHOOL IN EDGECOMBE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Edgecombe County Public Schools the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to create, in partnership with the Phoenix Society for African American Research, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, a replica of a two-teacher Rosenwald School building on the grounds of the W.A. Pattillo A+ School. The replica will serve as (i) a museum featuring photographs, oral history interviews, artifacts, and other items, (ii) a classroom equipped to teach the history of African-American education, and (iii) an office for the Phoenix Society.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
