A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROTECT THE IDENTITY OF INDIVIDUALS BY REQUIRING
2 FINGERPRINTS AND PHOTOGRAPHS BE TAKEN FOR MOTOR VEHICLE
3 VIOLATIONS OF FAILING TO PRODUCE A LICENSE OR LEARNER'S
4 PERMIT TO ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER REQUESTING IT FOR
5 LAWFUL PURPOSES PURSUANT TO G.S. 20-29, AND VIOLATIONS OF THE
6 DRIVERS LICENSE AND LEARNER'S PERMIT PROVISIONS IN G.S. 20-30.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 15A-502(b) reads as rewritten:

9 **"§ 15A-502. Photographs and fingerprints.**

10 (b) This section does not authorize the taking of photographs or fingerprints
11 when the offense charged is a Class 2 or 3 misdemeanor under Chapter 20 of the
12 General Statutes, "~~Motor Vehicles.~~"Vehicles," except for violations of G.S. 20-29 or
13 any of the provisions of G.S. 20-30."

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2006, and applies to
15 offenses committed on or after that date.
