1                                   A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT  
3 COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE IMPACT OF STUDENT MOBILITY ON  
4 ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6           **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall  
7 study the impact of student mobility on academic performance. In the course of the  
8 study, the Committee shall consider:

- 9           (1) The mobility rates of different student populations, especially those at  
10 risk of academic failure, and the relationship between high mobility  
11 rates and student performance for different student populations;  
12           (2) Impediments to receiving a sound basic education that are a product of  
13 high mobility rates; and  
14           (3) Strategies for meeting the needs of students who move frequently,  
15 especially students at risk of academic failure.

16           The Committee shall report the results of its study to the 2006 Regular  
17 Session of the 2005 General Assembly.

18           **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
