A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE
REVENUE TAX EVASION PROJECT AND FOR STAFF DEVELOPMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the Highway Trust Fund Administration to the Department of Revenue, Motor Fuels Tax Division, the sum of five hundred forty-eight thousand six hundred thirty-four dollars (\$548,634) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of four hundred seventy thousand seven hundred two dollars (\$470,702) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be used to establish and support nine positions to fully implement the Revenue Tax Evasion Project.

SECTION 2. The 10 time-limited positions established for the Revenue Tax Evasion Project in S.L. 2004-124 are converted to permanent positions, and the funds appropriated for those time-limited positions shall be used to support the permanent positions.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act is effective when it becomes law. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
