1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT AMENDING THE STATE PERSONNEL ACT TO PROTECT THE
3	PRIVACY OF CERTAIN PERSONAL AND EMPLOYMENT-RELATED
4	INFORMATION PERTAINING TO STATE EMPLOYEES.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 126-22 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 126-22. Personnel files not subject to inspection under § 132-6.
8	Personnel files of State employees, former State employees, or applicants for State
9	employment shall not be subject to inspection and examination as authorized by
10	G.S. 132-6. This does not include records open to inspection pursuant to G.S. 126-23 or
11	information released pursuant to G.S. 126-24. For purposes of this Article, a personnel
12	file consists of any employment-related or personal information gathered by the
13	department, department, university, division, bureau, commission, council, or other
14	agency subject to Article 7 of this Chapter which employs an individual, previously
15	employed an individual, or considered an individual's application for employment, or by
16	the office Office of State Personnel, and which information relates to the individual's
17	application, selection or nonselection, promotions, demotions, transfers, leave, salary,
18	benefits, suspension, performance evaluation forms, potential or actual disciplinary
19	actions, and termination of employment wherever located and in whatever form.
20	Personnel files of former State employees who have been separated from State
21	employment for 10 or more years may be open to inspection and examination except for
22	papers and documents relating to demotions and to disciplinary actions resulting in the
23	dismissal of the employee."
24	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
