A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE THE  
2 FOLLOWING SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES: AIR MEDAL RECIPIENT,  
3 ALPHA PHI ALPHA FRATERNITY, ARC OF NORTH CAROLINA, AUTISM  
4 SOCIETY OF NORTH CAROLINA, BUDDY PELLETIER SURFING  
5 FOUNDATION, COASTAL CONSERVATION ASSOCIATION, COLD WAR  
6 VETERAN, CORVETTE CLUB, GUILFORD BATTLEGROUND COMPANY,  
7 MARINE CORPS LEAGUE, NATIONAL MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS SOCIETY,  
8 NATIONAL WILD TURKEY FEDERATION, NORTH CAROLINA  
9 AQUARIUMS, NORTH CAROLINA LIBRARIES, NORTH CAROLINA  
10 MUSEUM OF NATURAL SCIENCES, NORTH CAROLINA WILDLIFE  
11 HABITAT FOUNDATION, OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM, OPERATION  
12 IRAQI FREEDOM, SCUBA, SHAG DANCING, SHARE THE ROAD, AND  
13 TARHEEL CLASSIC THUNDERBIRD CLUB.

15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

17 "(b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number  
18 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina,  
19 which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of  
20 expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and  
21 weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is  
22 a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a  
23 trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for  
24 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted".

25 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the  
26 Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for  
27 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have

1 the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and  
 2 numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying  
 3 over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The  
 4 following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate. The  
 5 design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division  
 6 and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.

- 8 (2) Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation.
- 9 (3) Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation.
- 10 (4) Friends of the Appalachian Trail.
- 11 (5) NC Coastal Federation.

- 13 (7) Stock Car Racing Theme.
- 14 (8) Buddy Pelletier Surfing Foundation.
- 15 (9) Guilford Battleground Company.
- 16 (10) National Wild Turkey Federation.
- 17 (11) North Carolina Aquarium Society.
- 18 (12) First in Forestry.
- 19 (13) North Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation."

20 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4(a) reads as rewritten:

21 "(a) General. – Upon application and payment of the required registration fees, a  
 22 person may obtain from the Division a special registration plate for a motor vehicle  
 23 registered in that person's name if the person qualifies for the registration plate. A  
 24 holder of a special registration plate who becomes ineligible for the plate, for whatever  
 25 reason, must return the special plate within 30 days. A special registration plate may not  
 26 be issued for a vehicle registered under the International Registration Plan. A special  
 27 registration plate may be issued for a commercial vehicle that is not registered under the  
 28 International Registration Plan. A special registration plate may not be developed using  
 29 a name or logo for which a trademark has been issued unless the holder of the trademark  
 30 licenses, without charge, the State to use the name or logo on the special registration  
 31 plate. ~~A holder of a special registration plate who becomes ineligible for the plate, for~~  
 32 ~~whatever reason, must return the special plate within 30 days."~~

33 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

34 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration  
 35 plates:

- 37 (1b) Air Medal Recipient. – Issuable to the recipient of the Air Medal. The  
 38 plate shall bear the emblem of the Air Medal and the words 'Air  
 39 Medal'.
- 40 ...
- 41 (1d) Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity. – Issuable to a member or supporter of the  
 42 Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The  
 43 plate shall bear the fraternity's symbol and name.

44 ...

- 1           (3b) ARC of North Carolina. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor  
 2           vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the logo  
 3           of The ARC of North Carolina, Inc., and the phrase "The ARC".  
 4       (~~3b~~)(3c) Audubon North Carolina. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor  
 5           vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the  
 6           National Audubon Society, Inc., logo and a representation of a bird  
 7           native to North Carolina.  
 8           (3d) Autism Society of North Carolina. – Issuable to the registered owner  
 9           of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall  
 10          bear the phrase "Autism Society of North Carolina", the phrase  
 11          "Providing Support, Promoting Opportunities", and the logo of the  
 12          Autism Society.  
 13       (~~3e~~)(3e) Aviation Maintenance Technician. – Issuable to a person who is a  
 14           Federal Aviation Authority certified Aviation Maintenance  
 15           Technician. The plate shall bear the logo of the F.A.A. Airworthiness  
 16           Program and the initials "A.M.T." The Division may not issue the  
 17           plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300  
 18           applications for the plate.  
 19       (~~3e~~)(3f) Be Active NC. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in  
 20           accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Be  
 21           Active NC" and a representation of the "Be Active NC" logo.  
 22          ...  
 23       (3l) Buddy Pelletier Surfing Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner  
 24          of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall  
 25          bear the words "Buddy Pelletier Surfing Foundation" and bear the logo  
 26          of the Foundation.  
 27          ...  
 28       (8d) Coastal Conservation Association. – Issuable to the registered owner  
 29          of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall  
 30          bear the logo and name of the Coastal Conservation Association.  
 31          ...  
 32       (8g) Cold War Veteran. – Issuable to a veteran of the armed services of the  
 33          United States who served during the Cold War era, September 2, 1945,  
 34          through December 26, 1991, and who was separated from the armed  
 35          services under honorable conditions. The plate shall bear the words  
 36          'Cold War Veteran' and an insignia representing the Cold War era. The  
 37          Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless  
 38          it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.  
 39          ...  
 40       (10e) Corvette Club. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle.  
 41          The plate shall bear the flags logo of the Chevrolet Corvette. The  
 42          Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless  
 43          it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.  
 44          ...

1           (16c) Guilford Battleground Company. – Issuable to the registered owner of  
 2           a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear  
 3           the phrase "Revolutionary" used by the Guilford Battleground  
 4           Company and an image that depicts General Nathaniel Greene.

5       ~~(16e)~~(16d) Harley Owners' Group. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor  
 6       vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall be designed  
 7       in consultation with and approved by the Harley-Davidson Motor  
 8       Company, Inc., and shall bear the words and trademark of the "Harley  
 9       Owners' Group". ~~The Division shall not develop this plate unless the~~  
 10       ~~Harley Davidson Motor Company, Inc., licenses, without charge, the~~  
 11       ~~State to use the words and trademark of the Harley Owners' Group on~~  
 12       ~~the plate.~~

13       ...

14       (24a) Marine Corps League. – Issuable to a member of the Marine Corps  
 15       League. The plate shall bear the words 'Marine Corps League' or the  
 16       letters 'MCL' and the emblem of the Marine Corps League. The  
 17       Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless  
 18       it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

19       ...

20       (27b) Military Wartime Veteran. – Issuable to either a member or veteran of  
 21       the armed services of the United States who served during a period of  
 22       war. If the person is a veteran of the armed services, then the veteran  
 23       must be separated from the armed services under honorable conditions.  
 24       The plate shall bear a word or phrase identifying the period of war and  
 25       a replica of the campaign badge or medal awarded for that war. Except  
 26       for World War II and Korean Conflict plates, the Division may not  
 27       issue a plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least  
 28       300 applications for that plate. A "period of war" is any of the  
 29       following:

- 30       a.     World War I, meaning the period beginning April 16, 1917, and  
 31       ending November 11, 1918.
- 32       b.     World War II, meaning the period beginning December 7,  
 33       1941, and ending December 31, 1946.
- 34       c.     The Korean Conflict, meaning the period beginning June 27,  
 35       1950, and ending January 31, 1955.
- 36       d.     The Vietnam Era, meaning the period beginning August 5,  
 37       1964, and ending May 7, 1975.
- 38       e.     Desert Storm, meaning the period beginning August 2, 1990,  
 39       and ending April 11, 1991.
- 40       f.     Operation Enduring Freedom, meaning the period beginning  
 41       October 24, 2001, and ending at a date to be determined.
- 42       g.     Operation Iraqi Freedom, meaning the period beginning March  
 43       19, 2003, and ending at a date to be determined.



- 1           (28u) North Carolina Libraries. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
- 2           vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
- 3           words "North Carolina Libraries" and bear the international logo for
- 4           libraries. The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
- 5           plate before it may be developed.
- 6           (28w) North Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation. – Issuable to the owner of
- 7           a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear
- 8           the logo of the North Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation on the left
- 9           side and the background of the entire plate shall be beige or tan color.
- 10          The numbers or other writing on the plate shall be black and the border
- 11          shall be black. The plate shall be developed by the Division in
- 12          consultation with and approved by the North Carolina Wildlife Habitat
- 13          Foundation. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this
- 14          subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.
- 15          ...
- 16          ~~(28g)~~(28y) Nurses. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
- 17          accordance with G.S. 20- 81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "First
- 18          in Nursing" and a representation relating to nursing.
- 19          ...
- 20          (34) Professional Sports Fan. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
- 21          vehicle. The plate shall bear the logo of a professional sports team
- 22          located in North Carolina. The Division shall receive 300 or more
- 23          applications for a professional sports fan plate before a plate may be
- 24          issued. ~~The Division shall not develop a professional sports fan plate~~
- 25          ~~unless the professional sports team licenses, without charge, the State~~
- 26          ~~to use the official team logo on the plate.~~
- 27          ...
- 28          (35d) Red Hat Society. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle.
- 29          The plate shall bear a representation of The Red Hat Society. ~~The~~
- 30          ~~Division shall not use the name and logo of The Red Hat Society, Inc.,~~
- 31          ~~on the plate unless The Red Hat Society, Inc., licenses, without charge,~~
- 32          ~~the State to use the name and logo on the plate.~~ The Division must
- 33          receive 300 or more applications for the plate before it may be
- 34          developed.
- 35          ...
- 36          (38c) Shag Dancing. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
- 37          accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear the phrase "I'd
- 38          Rather Be Shaggin'" and a picture representing shag dancing.
- 39          (38d) Share the Road. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle
- 40          in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a representation
- 41          of a bicycle and the phrase 'Share the Road'.
- 42          ...

(38f) SCUBA. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "SCUBA" and a logo of the Diver Down Flag.

...

(45h) Tarheel Classic Thunderbird Club. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle. The plate shall bear the logo of the Tarheel Classic Thunderbird Club and the phrase "Tarheel Classic Thunderbird Club". The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate."

**SECTION 4.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

**SECTION 5.** G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

**SECTION 6.** G.S. 20-81.12(b2) reads as rewritten:

"(b2) State Attraction Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a State attraction plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of State attraction plates to the organizations named below in proportion to the number of State attraction plates sold representing that organization:

(1) Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation. – The revenue derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation for use in promoting and preserving the Blue Ridge Parkway as a scenic attraction in North Carolina.

(1a) Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. – The revenue derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Inc., to be used for educational materials, preservation programs, capital improvements for the portion of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park that is located in North Carolina, and operating expenses of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

(1b) Friends of the Appalachian Trail. – The revenue derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to The Appalachian Trail Conference to be used for educational materials, preservation programs, trail maintenance, trailway and viewshed acquisitions, trailway and viewshed easement acquisitions, capital improvements for the portions of the Appalachian Trail and connecting trails that are located in North Carolina, and related administrative and operating expenses.

(1c) The North Carolina Aquariums. – The revenue derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the North Carolina Aquarium Society, Inc., for its programs in support of the North Carolina Aquariums.

- 1 (1c) The North Carolina Arboretum. – The revenue derived from the  
2 special plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina  
3 Arboretum Society and used to help the Society obtain grants for the  
4 North Carolina Arboretum and for capital improvements to the North  
5 Carolina Arboretum.
- 6 (1d) The North Carolina Maritime Museum. – The revenue derived from  
7 the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to Friends of the  
8 Museum, North Carolina Maritime Museum, Inc., to be used for  
9 educational programs and conservation programs and for operating  
10 expenses of the North Carolina Maritime Museum.
- 11 (1e) The North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences. – The revenue  
12 derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the  
13 Friends of the North Carolina State Museum of Natural Sciences for its  
14 programs in support of the museum.
- 15 (2) The North Carolina Zoological Society. – The revenue derived from  
16 the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina  
17 Zoological Society, Incorporated, to be used for educational programs  
18 and conservation programs at the North Carolina Zoo at Asheboro and  
19 for operating expenses of the North Carolina Zoo at Asheboro."

20 **SECTION 7.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding the following new  
21 subsections to read:

22 "(b39) Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
23 applications for the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity plate before the plate may be developed.  
24 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction  
25 Plate Account derived from the sale of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity plates to the  
26 Association of North Carolina Alphas (ANCA) Educational Foundation for  
27 scholarships for the benefit of African-American males in ANCA attending accredited  
28 North Carolina colleges and universities.

29 (b40) ARC of North Carolina. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
30 applications for the Arc of North Carolina plate before the plate may be developed. The  
31 Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction  
32 Plate Account derived from the sale of the Arc of North Carolina plates to The Arc of  
33 North Carolina, Inc., for its programs in support of retarded citizens in North Carolina.

34 (b41) Autism Society of North Carolina. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
35 applications for an Autism Society of North Carolina plate before the plate may be  
36 developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and  
37 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Autism Society of North  
38 Carolina plates to the Autism Society of North Carolina, Inc., for support services to  
39 individuals with autism and their families.

40 (b42) Buddy Pelletier Surfing Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
41 applications for the Buddy Pelletier Surfing Foundation plate before the plate may be  
42 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and  
43 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of the Buddy Pelletier Surfing

1 Foundation to the Foundation to fund the Foundation's scholastic and humanitarian aid  
2 programs.

3 (b43) Coastal Conservation Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
4 applications for the Coastal Conservation Association plate before the plate may be  
5 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and  
6 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of the Coastal Conservation  
7 Association plates to the Division of Marine Fisheries for its conservation programs.

8 (b44) Guilford Battleground Company. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
9 applications for a Guilford Battleground Company plate before the plate may be  
10 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and  
11 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Guilford Battleground  
12 Company plates to the Guilford Battleground Company for its programs.

13 (b45) National Multiple Sclerosis Society. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
14 applications for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society plate before the plate may be  
15 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and  
16 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of the National Multiple  
17 Sclerosis Society plates to the National Multiple Sclerosis Society for its public  
18 awareness programs.

19 (b46) National Wild Turkey Federation. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
20 applications for the National Wild Turkey Federation plate before the plate may be  
21 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and  
22 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of the National Wild Turkey  
23 Federation plates to the North Carolina State Chapter of the National Wild Turkey  
24 Federation for special projects to benefit the public.

25 (b47) SCUBA. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
26 SCUBA plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly  
27 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Plate Account derived for the sale of the  
28 SCUBA plates to the Division of Marine Fisheries for the purpose of developing the  
29 State's artificial reefs.

30 (b48) Share the Road. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
31 Share the Road plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
32 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived  
33 from the sale of the Share the Road plates to the Department of Transportation, Division  
34 of Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation, for its programs.

35 (b49) North Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation. – The Division must receive 300  
36 or more applications for the North Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation plate before the  
37 plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the  
38 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of the North  
39 Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation plates to the North Carolina Wildlife Habitat  
40 Foundation for its programs.

41 (b50) Shag Dancing. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
42 Shag Dancing plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
43 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived  
44 from the sale of Shag Dancing plates to the Hall of Fame Foundation.

1        (b51) North Carolina Libraries. – The Division must receive 300 or more  
2 applications for the North Carolina Libraries plate before the plate may be developed.  
3 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction  
4 Plate Account derived from the sale of the North Carolina Libraries plates to the North  
5 Carolina Library Association, Inc., for the Association's public programs."

6                **SECTION 8.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
