18 19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER FOR TRANSLATIONAL BIOTECHNOLOGY AT WINSTON-SALEM STATE UNIVERSITY AND TO COVER OPERATING COSTS OF THE CENTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to be allocated to Winston-Salem State University to establish the Center for Translational Biotechnology, a research facility that will provide undergraduate and graduate-level education and core laboratory support for biotechnology research training.

SECTION 1.(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to Winston-Salem State University for operating costs of the Center for Translational Biotechnology.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
