A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE AN FUNDS TO DEPARTMENT OF 3 ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES FOR REGIONAL COUNCILS 4 OF GOVERNMENT TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A WATER RESOURCE 5 MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6

7 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 8 Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of one million two hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,275,000) for fiscal year 2005-2006 and the sum of one 9 10 million two hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,275,000) for fiscal year 11 2006-2007. Of these funds, the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) shall be allocated to each of the State's 17 regional councils of government. These funds shall 12 be used by each regional council of government to develop and implement a 13 14 nonregulatory water resource management program through the voluntary cooperation of local governments, water users, other stakeholders, and the Department of 15 16 Environment and Natural Resources.

17 SECTION 2. In developing and implementing the water resource management program, each regional council of government shall carry out a plan of 18 work that may include, but not be limited to, the following: 19

Development of one or more multijurisdictional water resource 20 (1)management plans in cooperation with local governments and key 21 22 water user stakeholders, and the Department of Environment and 23 Natural Resources, based on the water resource needs, geographic and hydrologic features in the region, including both surface and 24 25 groundwater resources as appropriate to the region.

Convening coalitions of local governments and major water users in 26 (2)the respective regions to set strategies for sustaining water resources 27 necessary to support sound economic development. 28
