11	(2) To reduce class sizes in our public schools, to fund items necessary	
12	accomplish those ends, and to provide for more one-on-one instruction	
13	to allow teachers to teach and children to learn so that more children	en
14	will stay in school, graduate, and go on to college.	
15	(3) To fund school construction projects, including paying the princip	
16	and interest on bonds that were issued on or after January 1, 2003, f	
17	school construction as long as the counties continue their local scho	ol
18	construction maintenance of effort.	,
19	The funds from the Education Lottery shall supplement other State fund	as
20	appropriated for education.	
21	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
