A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CASWELL BEACH TO REGULATE 3 GOLF CARTS ON PUBLIC STREETS OR HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN 4 OR ON PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY THE TOWN. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** This act applies to the Town of Caswell Beach only. 6 7 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54, 8 a town may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of golf carts on any public or private street or highway within the city limits, or on any property owned or leased by the city. 9 By ordinance, a city may require the registration of golf carts, charge a fee for 10 11 the registration, specify who is authorized to operate golf carts, and specify the required 12 equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of golf carts.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
