A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE
2 REVENUE TAX EVASION PROJECT AND FOR STAFF DEVELOPMENT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the Highway Trust Fund
6 Administration to the Department of Revenue, Motor Fuels Tax Division, the sum of
7 five hundred forty-eight thousand six hundred thirty-four dollars (\$548,634) for the
8 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of four hundred seventy thousand seven hundred two
9 dollars (\$470,702) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be used to establish and support nine
10 positions to fully implement the Revenue Tax Evasion Project.

11 **SECTION 2.** The 10 time-limited positions established for the Revenue Tax
12 Evasion Project in S.L. 2004-124 are converted to permanent positions, and the funds
13 appropriated for those time-limited positions shall be used to support the permanent
14 positions.

15 **SECTION 3.** Section 2 of this act is effective when it becomes law. The
16 remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
