A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RESTORE THE CUT IN ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL POSITIONS AND TO MAKE ALL ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS TWELVE-MONTH EMPLOYEES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of five million thirty-eight thousand four hundred thirty-three dollars (\$5,038,433) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to allot assistant principal positions on the basis of one 10 month position per 761 average daily membership.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of nineteen million three hundred sixteen thousand one hundred seventy-four dollars (\$19,316,174) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to make all assistant principals 12 month employees.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
