Whereas, the elementary and middle schools in the Town of Trenton continue		
to use septic tanks; and		
Whereas, storms have often led to sewage overflow, causing these schools to		
close and prompting health concerns for students and school personnel; and		
Whereas, the Jones County Commissioners and the School Board support the		
installation of sewer lines to these schools; Now, therefore,		
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
Sl	ECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to	Jones County
the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to extend		
sewer lines to the schools in the Town of Trenton that are currently using septic tanks.		

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
