Short Title: Exempt Certain Farm Vehicle Registrations. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN FARM VEHICLES AND IMPLEMENTS FROM  
3 REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-51 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:  
6 "§ 20-51. Exempt from registration.

7 The following shall be exempt from the requirement of registration and certificate of  
8 title:

9 ...

10 (16) Any vehicle that meets all of the following:

- 11 a. Is designed for use in work off the highway.  
12 b. Is a farm implement or tractor as defined in G.S. 20-4.01 and is  
13 used solely for agricultural purposes.  
14 c. The farm implement or tractor as defined in G.S. 20-4.01 and  
15 shall be used for a period of time less than five weeks out of  
16 any calendar year.  
17 c. Is driven or moved on the highway for the purpose of going to  
18 and from nonhighway projects.  
19 d. Is identified in a manner approved by the Division of Motor  
20 Vehicles.  
21 e. Is operated by a person who is exempt from licensing  
22 requirements of G.S. 20-8(2)."

23 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2007.
