**SESSION LAW 2005-186
SENATE BILL 3**

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF NURSING TO
REQUIRE APPLICANTS TO SUBMIT EVIDENCE OF CONTINUING
COMPETENCY UPON LICENSE RENEWAL OR REINSTATEMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 90-171.23(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
read:

"(b) Duties, powers. The Board is empowered to:

...
(20) Adopt rules requiring an applicant to submit to the Board evidence of
the applicant's continuing competence in the practice of nursing at the
time of license renewal or reinstatement.
..."

...
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
