SENATE BILL 449*

Short Title: Anson County 911 Funds. (Local)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT EXPANDING PERMITTED USES OF 911 FUNDS IN ANSON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 62A-8(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Money from the Emergency Telephone System Fund shall be used only to pay for:

(1) The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone equipment, including necessary computer hardware, software and database provisioning, mobile or portable radio receivers and transmitters, base stations, communications towers, and other equipment necessary for interconnectivity between public safety agencies; addressing, addressing; and nonrecurring costs of establishing a 911 system, and system.

(2) The rates associated with the service supplier's 911 service and other service supplier recurring charges.

(3) The training of telecommunications dispatchers.

(4) The remodeling or renovating of the 911 dispatch center."

SECTION 2. This act applies to Anson County only.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005, and applies to charges billed on or after that date.
