A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH SEVENTY-FIVE NEW
ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITIONS THROUGHOUT THE
STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of six million one hundred sixty-eight thousand nine hundred seventy-five dollars (\$6,168,975) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of five million eight hundred nineteen thousand four hundred dollars (\$5,819,400) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the 75 new assistant district attorney positions authorized by this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
