A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE TRANSPORTATION OF CERTAIN BUILDING
SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT FROM THE LIGHT-DUTY ROAD WEIGHT
LIMITATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-118(c)(4) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Exceptions. – The following exceptions apply to G.S. 20-118(b) and 20-118(e).

...

(4) A truck or other motor vehicle shall be exempt from ~~such~~the light-traffic road limitations provided for pursuant to G.S. 20-118(b)(4), when transporting supplies, material or equipment necessary to carry out a farming operation engaged in the production of meats and agricultural crops and livestock or poultry ~~by products or by-products,~~ a business engaged in the harvest or processing of seafood~~seafood,~~ or when transporting supplies, material, or equipment necessary for the construction of housing or land development when the destination of ~~such~~the vehicle and load is located solely upon ~~said~~ the light-traffic road."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
