SENATE BILL 66

Short Title: International Home Furnishings Market Funds. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR TRANSPORTATION AND MARKETING
3 COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE HIGH POINT INTERNATIONAL HOME
4 FURNISHINGS MARKET.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.(a)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the High
7 Point International Home Furnishings Market Authority, a nonprofit organization, the
8 sum of one million three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) for the 2005-2006
9 fiscal year for parking and transportation system costs associated with the High Point
10 International Home Furnishings Market.

11 **SECTION 1.(b)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the High
12 Point International Home Furnishings Market Authority, a nonprofit organization, the
13 sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal
14 year for marketing activities associated with the High Point International Home
15 Furnishings Market.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
