10	required to be registered under the laws of this State.		
11	a. "New motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle which has never		
12	been the subject of a sale other than between new motor vehicle		
13	dealers, or between manufacturer and dealer of the same		
14	franchise.vehicle:		
15	1. Which has never been the subject of a sale other than		
16	between new motor vehicle dealers or between the		
17	manufacturer and dealer of the same franchise; or		
18	<u>2.</u> <u>Which is offered for sale by a new motor vehicle dealer</u>		
19	and the vehicle's odometer mileage is 1,000 miles or less.		
20	For the purposes of this Article, a motor vehicle that has		
21	previously been the subject of a sale by a new motor vehicle		
22	dealer may nonetheless be considered new and represented to		
23	the public as a new motor vehicle, so long as the vehicle's		
24	odometer mileage does not exceed 1,000 miles:

12	(1) Actions or conduct violating this Article.	
13	(2) A violation of G.S. 20-71.4.	
14	(3) Arising out of the sale, maintenance, or repair of a	motor vehicle.
15	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
